In 1982 she graduated with honors from the Faculty of Medicine of Comenius University in general medicine. From 1982 to 1989, she worked as a secondary physician at the University Hospital in Bratislava, and since 1989, she has been working at the Faculty of Medicine of Comenius University. In 1998, she completed postgraduate studies in the field of normal and pathological physiology, in 2005 she qualified as an associate professor in this field, and in 2012, after the inauguration ceremony at Comenius University, she was appointed professor in the field of normal and pathological physiology. Since 2010, she is the head of the Institute of Physiology, Faculty of Medicine of Comenius University, where she has founded the Academic Center for Autism Research in 2013. Prof. Ostatnikova has completed study stays in the USA, and is a holder of a Fulbright fellowship and a Templeton fellowship. Thanks to a Fulbright scholarship, she completed a stay at the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor (2005) and, thanks to the Templeton Foundation, a stay at the University of Iowa (2008) in the USA. From 2014 to 2018, she was a visiting professor at Nova Southeastern University, Florida, USA. At the Mailman Segal Center for Human Development, she completed several stays focused on autism research. She is the responsible researcher of several research projects on autism.

She is a member of the European Academy of Sciences and Arts (Salzburg, Austria) and several other scientific societies at home and abroad. Since 2018, she has been responsible for the doctoral study program Medical Neuroscience at the Comenius University, Faculty of Medicine in Bratislava. She has received several international and national awards for her scientific and publishing activities. At the Faculty of Medicine of Comenius University in Bratislava, she held the position of Vice-Dean for International Relations from 2007 to 2015, from February 2015 to February 2019 she was Vice-Rector for International Relations of Comenius University in Bratislava, and from February 2023 she serves again as a Vice-Dean for International Relations at the Faculty of Medicine of Comenius University in Bratislava.

She is the winner of the Slovak Woman of the Year poll in the Science and Research category for 2012, the laureate of the Crystal Wing Extraordinary Lifetime Achievement Award for 2020, and the laureate of the ESET Science Award for 2023 in the Outstanding Academic in Slovakia category.


